In addition to providing 1:1 intensive intervention programs and classroom support, BIA has developed a number of other innovative programs including CREW; a recreational program offered on many school campuses during the recess portion of the school day to assist students in engaging successfully with their peers through facilitated interactive games.

As part of BIA's on-going efforts to provide strategies to families and professionals who struggle to address the social and communication needs of children with ASD, BIA has created an instructional DVD, **Passport To Friendship**.

AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM

The Village Clubhouse is a therapeutic after-school program for children, ages 5-12, who have social and communication challenges.



The Village Clubhouse offers elementary aged students the opportunity to participate in cooperative play and everyday activities within peer dyads and small groups. A limited number of spots will be available for siblings of participants!

CURRICULUM

The curriculum will be individualized based on the needs of each group.

Sample themes include:

- Comic Books/Super Heroes
- Recess Games Boot Camp
- Wood Working/Carpentry
- Action! Make a Movie
- Gardening



Each day will be highly structured with ample opportunities to learn new leisure skills while interacting with peers in a supported setting.

Sample Day:

1. Greeting (introduce a friend)
2. Warm Up with Music/Movement
3. Review of Daily Schedule
Shoot Hoops (Horse)
4. Self-Help Activity (Snack Prep)
5. Four Square Ball Play
6. Snack Time
7. Share your favorite part of the day
8. Shop at the Clubhouse store with points earned during the day
